## TALK ABOUT IT

**Read:** Acts 23:10-23:31

- The Bible doesn't say, but how old do you think Paul's nephew was?
- Do you think Paul's nephew was afraid to go in front of the Roman tribune?
- Do you think it was just a coincidence that Paul's nephew happened to overhear the plot - or do you think God placed him in exactly the right spot at exactly the right time?



## WAYS TO WORSHIP

God can use anyone to help others, as long as they are willing to say "yes" when He calls. Listen to **So Will I** by Hillsong Worship. Pay attention to the lyrics. Ask yourself - where might God want to send me? Am I willing to allow God to use me to help others no matter where or how He wants to do it?



## THINK ABOUT IT

**Read:** Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-27

- Why is each part of the human body important?
- Why is each part of the church, the body of Christ, important?
- What would happen if everyone in the church did the same thing?



## CHAIN REACTION

We should always be looking for ways to do good and serve others, especially because we believe in Jesus and want to share His love. As a family, take turns writing one way to "do good" on a strip of paper (such as praying for others, visiting a sick friend, or helping a classmate with homework). Start a paper chain by taping the ends of one strip together to make a circle. Attach the other strips together until the desired chain length is reached. Display the chain somewhere as a reminder that God wants to use you to help others!
