## TALK ABOUT IT

**Read:** Matthew 4:1-11

- What did Jesus do before He was tempted?
- What are the three ways the devil tempted Jesus?
- How did Jesus respond each time?



## WAYS TO WORSHIP

As a family, write down the ways you've been tempted in the last week. Using a concordance or online search engine, look up verses that might be helpful to remember if you are tempted in that way again. Pray as a family and ask God to help you remember His Word when temptations come - because they WILL be coming!



## THINK ABOUT IT

**Read:** Matthew 26:41 and Ephesians 6:13

- What are we to do so that we do not fall into temptation?
- What have we been given to help us stand against evil?
- Do you know what the armor of God is? (hint: read verses 14-18)



## GOD'S WORD STANDS

Fill a glass with water (tape a little sign on the glass that says "GOD'S WORD"). Give your child popcorn to throw AT the glass to try and knock it down. Tell your child that the popcorn represents TEMPTATION and the glass of water represents GOD'S WORD. God's Word will ALWAYS stand up to temptation! Afterwards, remove the sign and have a little fun by trying to throw the popcorn IN the glass of water.



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
