TALK ABOUT IT

Read: Matthew 14:22-33

- Why do you think Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey?
- What are some of the ways the people honored Jesus as He rode into town?
- What do you think the people who were shouting "Hosanna!" were expecting Jesus to do?



WORSHIP

Go to a park as a family, or outside your house if you live in a wooded area. Look at the trees around you and talk about what it might have looked like when the people in Jerusalem cut down branches to lay on the road before Jesus. God the Father sent Jesus to save us - but not necessarily from an oppressive government (like the Jews expected to be saved from the Romans). Jesus came to save us from the penalty of our sin - eternal separation from God. Talk about that, then pray and tell God thank you as you sit and enjoy the beauty of His creation.



THINK ABOUT IT

Read: Luke 23:26-23:43

- When He was being crucified, what did Jesus say in v. 34?
- Why do you think Jesus chose not to save Himself from dying on the cross?
- What was Jesus' response to the criminal who recognized that Jesus had done nothing wrong to deserve crucifixion? What does that tell you about God's mercy and grace?



PALM SUNDAY PALMS

You will need green construction paper, popsicle sticks, and glue. Have your child trace their hand multiple times on green construction paper. Cut out the hands and then glue multiple hands to the popsicle stick with the fingers pointing out. As you overlap the handprints it will start to look like a palm branch. When they are dry, wave the "branches" and shout together: "Hosanna, blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!"
