GOD IS CREATOR

MEMORY VERSE

Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect. **Romans 12:2 (NLT)**

BIBLE PASSAGES

DAY 1: Read - Genesis 1:1-8

In the beginning there was nothing. But then, God created. All God did was speak, and light appeared. This is not the light we know from the sun, but it was a special light from a source only God knew. God separated the light and dark on day one, and saw that it was good. On the second day, God divided the water into parts so that there would be water and air. Today, when you turn on or off a light, see water, or breathe in air, think about God the Creator and His amazing power!

DAY 2: Read - Genesis 1:9-13, Romans 11:36

Have you ever thought about what the appearance of dry land would have involved? Mountains, valleys, boulders, springs, rivers, waterfalls, caves, beaches, gravel, clay, and so much more appearing for the first time! God also knew we would need plants for food, clothing, and shelter. God the Creator thought of everything we would need before even creating us! Today, praise God the Creator for how He provides.

DAY 3: Read - Genesis 1:14-19, Psalm 8:1-4

Isn't it incredible how the Earth is just the right distance from the sun so that we receive the right amount of light and heat? Isn't it unbelievable how the moon, a rock, is able to reflect the light of the sun, giving us light at night? If you look into the night sky filled with stars, doesn't it amaze you at how big our God is! Tonight, go outside and look up at the stars. As you look at the stars, tell God how you feel about Him.

DAY 4: Read - Genesis 1:20-31

By day five, God's Creation was ready to receive living creatures! God had already created day, night, water, land, and plants. God now began to fill His Creation with living things. On day five He created all the creatures that live in the air and waters. Then, on day six God started by creating all land animals. But Creation wasn't complete. Next, God created Adam and Eve to be in relationship with Him. He created them in His own image. Praise God for creating you to be special to Him.

DAY 5: Read - Genesis 2:1-2, Psalm 121:4, Exodus 31:13

Why do you think God rested on day seven? God did not need to rest. He's God! He never even sleeps! God rested to give us an example of what our weeks should look like: six days of work and one day of rest. God rested and gave us an example for Sabbath. Unlike God, our bodies need physical and spiritual rest. Every week we should Sabbath, or have a day where we rest, relax, and focus on God.

Why did God rest? God does not need rest Himself, but He wanted to show that we are to set aside a special day for thinking about Him and the work He has done for us. This day of rest is known as Sabbath, and it is to be set aside as a special and holy period of time. The exact day of the week is not as important as the concept itself. Many people choose to honor the Sabbath on Sunday, but some people might have to work on Sundays and pick a different day to honor the Sabbath. What day you choose to Sabbath and what is considered work or not work are the kinds of details that the church leaders were so worried about in the times of Jesus, and they criticized Him for not following all of their picky rules. The important thing about the Sabbath is that we do have one day a week we set aside for rest and to focus our attention on God and what He has done for us..

Together, as a family, create your own Sabbath Day plan using the activity guide and family plan provided. You can also read about some great family friendly Sabbath ideas at Shine Bright Mom. Remember to make it about God, make it special, and make it restful.
