



# Safe Families - 3/8/2020

## OVERVIEW

Being a disciple and being on mission with Jesus takes intentionality. This week we looked at how God is using Safe Families and Blue Ridgers to help people follow Jesus. Through obedience to God and saying “Yes,” families are being transformed! We will ask the question, what is our response to caring for the orphans and widows?

Scripture (NIV): Mark 1:17; Matthew 9:35; John 3:16; James 1:27

## APPLICATION

- Maybe it's fear of being asked to do more, nervousness about God's next nudge or excitement to hear what God is doing. What emotions are evoked in you when you realize our service will revolve around being on mission?
- This morning we heard many stories of people saying “Yes” to what God has asked them to do. What is God asking you to do that you are not responding to with a “Yes”?
- James 1:27 says true religion is caring for orphans and widows in their distress. What does James mean by this? How could you as an individual (or we as a group) respond to this passage?
- Being a disciple is listening to what Jesus is calling you into and making changes, saying “Yes.” What is a practical step you can take this week that will move you closer to Jesus?
- HOMEWORK: This week let your penny remind you to pray about how you can be on mission in your spheres of influence. Ask God specifically to open your eyes to where He wants you to be involved.
