OVERVIEW

Have you ever had someone come to your door or stop you at the mall to share the Gospel of Jesus with you? A little uncomfortable, right? We are all called to share the Gospel, but the most effective ways of doing it change over time. In this new season, Woody shares that serving and missional living is going to draw others to Him. How are we living our lives in a way that helps people see Jesus?

Scripture: Mark 10:45

APPLICATION

- Have you ever shared the Gospel with someone? Did they surrender their life to Jesus? Share your experience. If you have never shared the Gospel with anyone, what holds you back from doing so?
- There are all kinds of personal styles of sharing the Gospel. A few examples are: direct style, testimonial style, intellectual style, and missional style. In your own words, how would you describe the way you share the Gospel with others?
- Woody said that as a culture and as a church we are “moving from a come and see church, to a go and be church!” That’s a missional style of sharing the Gospel of Jesus. What are your thoughts about this statement? What kind of fears does this statement cause for you?
- Jesus modeled serving through His death on the cross. He says, “I didn’t come to be served, but to serve.” How has your life reflected that statement?
- What can you do to prepare yourself to follow Jesus in this missional way?

Take Action: This week, start with prayer. Ask God to show you where you can live missionally. Pay careful attention to see how God is moving in you. And finally, “GO”! Take a practical step to meet the need of others for the sake of spreading the Gospel.
