## OVERVIEW

If we want to reach more and more people in our area, then we need to begin to operate in “new old ways”! The early church in Scripture didn’t have huge budgets, fancy productions, or marketing departments. We don’t have to reinvent the wheel. Luke 10 records for us the sending out of 72 disciples, which is a practical, Spirit-led process and pattern of going out and reaching the lost!

Scriptures: Luke 10:1; John 20:21; Matthew 28:20b; Acts 22:21

## APPLICATION

- Read Chapter 10 of Luke in its entirety. Before we start truly studying the chapter throughout this series, what is one thing that stood out to you at first glance?
- Looking at Luke 10:1, how would you answer these two questions?
  - a. What does this passage teach me about Jesus?**
  - b. What does this passage teach me about disciples?**
- We see in this first verse that Jesus appoints, He sends, and He’s going with them. How have you seen these three things play out in your own life?
- Jeremy had us repeat the phrases...I am appointed and sent. Jesus goes with me. I need others to join me. Is anything holding you back from believing these truths about yourself?
- **What does this mean to me?** Specifically answer this question as you study Luke 10:1.
- **TAKE ACTION:** Jeremy shared three questions (bolded above) that he uses as he studies Scripture. This week, and as the series continues, start studying Luke 10. Discover what God wants to reveal to you by answering these questions verse by verse.
