WAYS TO WORSHIP

God is always with His children. Go outside and look at your shadow. Walk back and forth and notice how your shadow stays with you all the time. Depending on where the light is, the shadow will change and sometimes even disappear. You might not always be able to see your shadow, but it is always right there ready to appear again when the light is right.

A BEAUTIFUL MOSAIC

God can use hard things for good. Get out some pieces of colored paper. Look at how perfect they are. How smooth and unwrinkled. Now, tear up the papers. They are no longer smooth and perfect. We might see tearing up the papers as bad, but with the smaller pieces, we can create a beautiful mosaic. Glue the small pieces onto paper to create a mosaic. Sometimes, we see things that happen to us as destroying something that we think is perfect, but God is really preparing the pieces to make a beautiful mosaic.
