

## GPS Obedience - 8/1/2021

## **OVERVIEW**

Jesus knows where He is going, and He has a plan for us to follow. When we listen, trust, and obey His voice, our response shows our deep love for Him. Jesus tells us to "go out and make disciples." Will we listen and obey? Making disciples is directly proportional to us being a disciple.

Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 10:1-12; Matthew 28:19-20; Luke 7:36-50

## **APPLICATION**

- Read Luke 7:47. How have you seen this statement to be true in your own life?
- Woody said, "Your response to God is directly proportional to your love for God." If that is true, does your life reflect a deep love for God or something else?
- Woody made the comparison of using a GPS (listening for instructions and obeying where to go) with how we listen to Jesus. We often hear Jesus' instructions, but choose not to listen and obey, so we go off course. When we get off course in our car, our GPS says, "recalculating" and tells us how to make a correction. Likewise, when we veer off God's course we need to repent (turn around). Is there an area in your life that is steering you away from being a disciple or a disciple maker?
- "Making disciples is directly proportional to you being a disciple." Why do you think this statement is true?
- God is calling us to obedience. In Luke's account of the woman who cleaned Jesus' feet with her hair, we see that she displayed her love for Him out of gratitude for what He had done for her. What has Jesus done in your life that you are thankful for and makes you want to follow and obey Him?
- NEXT STEP: Pray that God would give you the name of one person who you can come alongside in their discipleship journey. If you can't think of a name, ask God to help you identify what is hindering you from becoming a disciple-maker.
